She is a BE accredited Coach who has produced horses and riders from grass roots up to International levels in eventing, to Advanced Medium level dressage and Grade B showjumping.

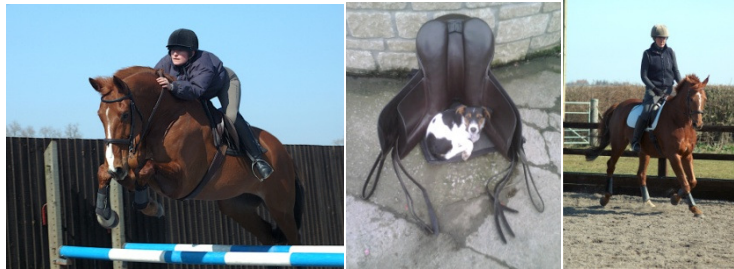

Are you tempted by the idea of a residential stay?

At Skylands we can be very flexible in how we run a course for our guests. We limit our guest numbers to 6 for any one course. There is on-site accommodation for 6 guests in the AA 4 diamond rated 17th Century farmhouse (1 double, 2 twin rooms). Alternatively, you are welcome to stay on-site in your lorry or caravan. A sitting room, lavatories and showers are available. Campers can choose whether to bring their own food or enjoy meals in the farmhouse.

Food at Skylands

All our food is homemade; it is locally produced and plentiful. Please note that we are not licensed to sell alcohol but adult guests are welcome to bring their own drink to the farm. At the beginning of your break we plan your menu for your stay.

We offer an excellent breakfast, coffee and biscuits, lunch and afternoon tea. We do not provide an evening meal for adult courses because we have found that after time in the saddle guests prefer to head out to a local pub or restaurant to eat. Stalbridge has an excellent supermarket, butchers and 2 takeaways so food is easy to organise for those who prefer to do their own catering. There are many restaurants in the area for any of our guests who would like a night out.



Five star living for your horse

Horses have lovely accommodation at Skylands. We have three small yards of Monarch internal stables. Stabled horses are welcome to be turned out for a few hours during their stay in our very well maintained fields. We have many covered; secure tying up areas for horses.

Flexibility is the key

Groups of guests do not need to be of a similar standard to enjoy a stay at Skylands. Our individual approach means you can enjoy the company of your friends or family whilst working at your own speed. If you would like to combine riding with touring, we offer half-and-half options, allowing you to ride each day and then head off into Dorset, Wiltshire or Somerset, possibly with a non-riding friend or relative. We offer superb B&B for non-riding guests and are happy to look after your horse whilst you enjoy your afternoons or evenings.

Example Timetable

Each group's timetable is tailored to their requirements. This timetable gives an example day at Skylands.

We are not limited to set dates; you decide when the club would like to have their break and what everyone would like from their trip. We arrange everything for you. If you have a high demand from Club members we can run two courses back to back for you.

We welcome groups of children and teenagers. Both riders and horses or ponies are very well cared for throughout their stay both on the equine and domestic side. Children's' groups require a little extra planning that is arranged between parents and Skylands.
